Europe – Economy - Mobility

Every year, Europe is growing closer together – in political, social and most importantly in economic aspects. As a result of this development, there are challenges which require a particular understanding of economic relationships in a unified Europe. These challenges require a readiness for mobility, extensive soft skills and business competence in order to be able to comfortably deal with international business questions.

That's where the European Business Baccaureate Diploma (EBBD) comes into play! With the EBBD, all young people who meet university admission requirements will receive a harmonized and accredited European qualification going beyond the national framework for professions in the field of business administration. Thus, the graduates of the EBBD program increase their opportunities on the job market.

Business Competence “European Style”

In the future, the European Economic Area will increasingly require broader and particular competencies. The EBBD curriculum has been specifically designed with these competencies in mind: the EBBD supports the European economy by educating a top qualified workforce. Graduates receive an additional, internationally renowned certificate, which also serves as preparation for academic studies with a European focus.

These competencies entail:

- > Business competence
- > Competence in international business fields
- > Europe Competence - CFEC
- > Competence in various foreign languages
- > Competence to work on economic questions in a foreign language – CLIL
- > Application of work related competencies during practical training in a foreign country
- > Problem solving competence in the framework of business projects and simulations
- > Soft skills

Europe is working together

International partners have teamed up to jointly develop the European Business Baccaureate Diploma and to establish a suitable curriculum, which is currently being evaluated. Starting in September 2012, the EBBD may also be implemented by schools, which have not yet been part of this project.

The non-profit organization “European Business Baccaureate Diploma e.V.” is in charge of carrying out the accreditations of such schools and establishing the rules for their certification.
